The following is a gear list for a “typical” scout camping trip. Equipment needs may vary by activity/outing.

- Sleeping bag
- Sleeping pad
- Pillow (optional)
- Camp chair**
- Clothes (for weather)
- Hiking boots or athletic shoes
- Extra socks
- Rain gear
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Flashlight
- Extra batteries
- Mess kit
- Water bottle
- Compass
- Personal snacks
- Class A uniform
- Class B T-shirt
- Ingredients for group meals as assigned
- Pocket knife*
- Matches or lighter*
- Small first aid kit**
- Bug spray**
- Sunscreen**
- Hot dog forks**
- Mountain Pie makers**

*For scouts who have earned Tote n Chit, and Fire n Chit.
